The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.34 dated 02.04.2015, under Sections 376, 511 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Rajasansi, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar

By an order dated 10.08.2017, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial court within seven days and move an application for setting aside the order dated 14.06.2016 declaring him as a proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the direction given by this court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial court on 16.08.2017 and furnished the bail bonds.

Learned DAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions

from the Investigating Officer, does not dispute this fact.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial court and furnished the bail bonds, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 10.08.2017 is made absolute.
