The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.66 dated 29.06.2015, under Sections 498-A, 406, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation.

Learned DAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigation Officer, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, still one LCD, one cooler, Rs.50,000/- cash given for

motorcycle and 03 gram gold are yet to be recovered from him.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation and mediation has failed in this case, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 22.09.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
