The petitioner has filed this petition against his parents-respondents No. 4 and 5, brother and his wife-respondents No. 6 and 7, claiming that after completing the schooling, the petitioner somehow managed to get admission in the College but the parents did not support him financially in his higher studies. As a result of the same, he could not complete his BA. It is further claimed that the parents has refused him to join their family business.

After going through the petition, I am of the view that no direction under Section 482 Cr. P.C. can be issued to the parents to allow the petitioner to join family business and must provide him higher education.

In view of the above the petition stands disposed of.

In the given circumstances, a warning is issued to the petitioner not to waste the precious time of the Court by filing such frivolous petitions.
