The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.62 dated 23.08.2016 for the offence under Sections 166(A), 232, 328, 366,376D, 506 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Women Panipat.

Petitioners are in custody since 23.08.2016.

Learned State counsel submits that during the trial, both the girls i.e. prosecutrix and her friend had turned hostile as per their deposition Annexures P-4 and P-5. He further submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners are not required.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that trial is not likely to mature in near future, petitioners be released on regular bail on furnishing their fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Panipat.
