Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.275 dated 18.09.2016 registered under Sections 448, 380, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise dated 05.10.2016 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 11.08.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana on 19.08.2017 and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received

vide letter bearing No.1291 dated 21.08.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana vide letter No.1773/EC dated 23.08.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, the complainant has compromised the matter with the petitioners out of his free will and without any inducement or pressure from the petitioners.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.275, is quashed qua the petitioners.
