The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 76, dated 13.03.2017, under Sections 302, 34 IPC (later on Section 302 IPC deleted and Section 304 IPC added), registered at Police Station Bahin, Palwal, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that while the petitioner was reversing his vehicle, 10 months old child was run over. He further contends that offence under Section 304 IPC is, prima-facie, not made out as per the allegations in the FIR. The petitioner is in custody ever since the date of his arrest on 16.03.2017.

Learned State counsel contends that the investigation has been completed and the charges have been framed in the case on 13.07.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has

been in custody for over 05 months, the investigation has been completed and completion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Lokesh Kumar is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
