Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C is for quashing of order dated 01.02.2014 passed by JMIC, Amritsar whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender in complaint filed by the respondent- complainant and further for staying the operation of the impugned order by not arresting the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order passed by this Court on March 17, 2015, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted on bail. This fact has not been disputed by the respondent.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that it being a private complaint filed by the respondent-complainant under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B and 34 IPC and the petitioner has appeared to face trial, this Court finds that the present petition

no more survives and is disposed of as such.

However, in case the trial is continuing, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court unless exemption is granted to him.
