JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 the Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in case FIR No.201 dated 09.04.2016 registered under Sections 304-B and 506 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is bald allegation of demand of buffalo and harassment qua all the three accused. The petitioner is the mother-in-law. She is in custody since 10.05.2016. There is none to look after the requirements of young child of the deceased, the grand child of the petitioner. The material witnesses have been examined. The similarly placed co-accused had been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 19.07.2017 (Annexure P-5).

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, on instructions submits that there are specific allegations against the petitioner of harassment and repeated demand of buffalo. One buffalo was supplied to the in-laws of the deceased. However, there is no record of the same.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the allegations are general in nature qua all the accused; the similarly placed accused had already been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 19.07.2017 (Annexure P-5), the young child of the deceased is to be looked after and the petitioner is in custody since 10.05.2016, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate concerned.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
