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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner No. 2 claims that he had filed a civil suit, in which status quo order was granted to the Gram Panchayat and Sarpanch of Village Rauni, Tehsil Payal, District Ludhiana, and that respondents No. 4 to 14, at the behest of respondent No. 15, have put a lock on his property and threatened him, for which he has filed representation dated 17.7.2017 (Annexure-P-6) before the police. The prayer is to direct the police to decide the said representation.

I am of the view that the said representation is nothing, but a criminal complaint. The police is already looking into the said representation. If according to the petitioners, the inquiry officer is going on slow, it is appropriate to make a complaint to the higher officer, in place of approaching this Court and if there is breach of status quo order of the civil court, the civil court is the proper forum to be approached for breach of the status quo order.
