The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.09 dated 05.01.2016 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Chandigarh.

Vide order dated 28.01.2016, arrest of the petitioner was stayed and thereafter, matter was referred for mediation and the matter was amicably resolved in terms of compromise dated 24.05.2017 duly signed by both the parties. The same has been placed on record today on the case file. In terms of compromise, out of Rs.40,00,000/- as permanent alimony, petitioner has paid Rs.15,00,000/- to the respondent- Simarjit Kaur and remaining amount of Rs.25,00,000/- shall be deposited in this Court, in the shape of FDR in the name of Arzoyi Singh and shall be released to the respondent-Simarjit Kaur after the FIR is quashed and marriage is dissolved. Both the parties submit that they will be bound by the terms of compromise.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of and interim bail granted vide order dated 28.01.2016 is made absolute.
