The present petition has been filed by Kirandeep Kaur daughter of Sukhwinder Kaur and Kaka Singh respondents No.4 and 5 alleging that her life and liberty needs to be protected from her mother who is indulging in illicit affairs with respondent No.6. The petitioner has not levelled any allegations against her father. Prima facie, the story does not appear to be convincing that during lifetime of her father who is staying in the same house, the mother could exploit her position as sought to be portrayed in the representation as well as in the petition.

Nevertheless, without examining the correctness or otherwise of the allegations brought-forth by the petitioner, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into grievance of the petitioner only qua her mother and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances. The representation of the petitioner shall be disposed of within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
