This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 429 dated 23.09.2016, under Section 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 10 of the POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Tohana, District Fatehabad.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 28.11.2016. It is also contended that the prosecutrix was taking tuition from the petitioner and he used to treat her like his daughter while further submitting that the present FIR has been got registered in some misunderstanding.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application. She submits that the statements of the complainant and the prosecutrix have been recorded.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view

the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 28.11.2016; the statements of the complainant and the prosecutrix have been recorded and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
