Petitioner-Satyajit Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.201 dated 13.10.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amrtisar, under Sections 302, 307, 212, 216, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of complainant-Babbal Joseph. The

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present petitioner is named in the FIR and injuries by way of beating are specifically attributed to him. Out of 28 witnesses, only 02 witnesses have been examined.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the facts that case is at preliminary stage; there is every chance of tampering with the evidence, if the petitioner is released on bail and that active role has been attributed to him, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
