The petitioners have filed these petitions under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.125 dated 30.12.2016 registered under Sections 21/61/85 at Police Station Lahori Gate, District Patiala.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned State counsel submits that there is no other case against both the petitioners. The petitioners are women and both were arrested on 30.12.2016 and since then they are in jail. The trial will take its own time.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, on the asking of the Court, makes a statement that the petitioners will file undertaking on

affidavit that they would not indulge in any type of offence and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station.

In view of the fact that the petitioners are ready to give affidavit as stated above and the further fact that no other case is reported against them, and the investigation has been completed, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-29353 OF 2017 and CRL. MISC. No.30003 OF 2017 are allowed.
- (ii) The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioners shall report to the police station concerned on every Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday from 11.00am to 4.00pm in addition to appearing before the trial Court on the dates fixed there.
- (iv) The petitioners shall give undertaking to the police as aforesaid that they will not indulge in such type of offence in future.
- (v) In case of violation of the above condition on the part of the petitioners, the liberty is reserved in favour of the State to apply for cancellation of bail.
