Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have already joined investigation in compliance of interim bail granted by this Court. They are ready to face proceedings, in accordance with law. It is further submitted that the husband and his brother were arrested in the case and they have been released on bail.

Counsel for the State has submitted that part of the recovery is yet to be effected.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioners vide

order dated 30.8.2016 is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) They shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
- (ii) They shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and
- (iii) They shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
