This is a petition under Section 439 Cr. P.C. for grant of regular bail to petitioner in case FIR No. 358 dated 8.10.2016 under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that though in the FIR, it is alleged that apart from snatching the scooter and money, petitioner has also given beatings to the complainant- Sukhram and, however, there is no MLR of the complainant.

It is further submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that there is delay of 3 days in lodging the FIR as the incident is of 5.10.2016 and FIR was registered on 8.10.2016. He further submits that the statement of the complainant - Sukhram (PW-2) has already been recorded and only the statement of official witness remains. He further submits that petitioner is in judicial lock up since 31.1.2017; he is on bail in other two cases and has not misused the concession of bail in both the cases.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jamshed does not dispute the factual position.

Keeping in view the above fact and without commenting upon the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/CJM, Palwal.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail in case the petitioner is found involved in any other subsequent case or found misusing concession of bail.
