HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Petitioner-Ajaib Singh has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for taking action on his application dated 20.12.2016 (Annexure P-2), as the private respondents have caused injuries to him after entering into his house. Prayer has also been made to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

The alleged incident took place on 18.09.2016. As per the complaint submitted by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, the accused have entered into the house of the complainant and have caused injuries to him for which the petitioner got treatment from Civil Hospital, Nihal Singh Wala. He was medically examined by the doctor, who prepared the MLR and in this respect, rapat No.8 dated 20.09.2016 was also registered, but the police

officials did not take any action thereon. Thereafter, the petitioner submitted a representation dated 20.12.2016 (Annexure P-2) for taking action against the private respondents after registering the case.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds that the petitioner has not placed any material on record to state that after the submission of the complaint/representation dated 20.12.2016 (Annexure P-2), the accused has given threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

In the absence of any material on record to suggest that after 20.12.2016, respondents have given any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, present petition is dismissed.
