Heard learned counsel for the rival parties at length.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has taken me through the FIR extensively and submits that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner that he was paid an amount of ₹7 lacs by the complainant.

It appears from the entire reading of the FIR that the petitioner and one Harjit Kahlon and others have a unified gang operating to collect money from people with the promise to send them abroad and in this case to Canada.

Learned State counsel submits that there are several other complaints against the petitioner. Harjit Kahlon has not yet been arrested who appears to be the member of the gang of which the petitioner is also a member.

In that view of the matter, in the light of the prima-facie evidence against the petitioner, petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is dismissed. Petitioner as well as Harjit Kahlon be arrested forthwith.
