The employer-Jitender Singh had filed the present appeal assailing the order dated 22.10.2002, passed by the Commissioner, Workmen's Compensation Act, Ambala, whereby the claim petition of widow-Sunita Devi and minor son-Sahil on account of the deceased employee-Sant Ram was allowed and compensation for a sum of Rs.3,18,910/- along with 12% interest was awarded.

The present appeal was admitted, vide order dated 01.09.2003.

Learned Counsel for the appellant states that the present appeal has become infructuous in view of the awarded compensation having been deposited and disbursed to the claimants.
