Petitioner-Major Singh has filed the petition seeking quashing of FIR No.10 dated 9.2.2014 under Sections 341, 324, 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Raikot, District Ludhiana Rural at the instance of respondent No.2 Pashora Singh. Quashing is sought on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 16.8.2017 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise.

Report of the trial Court has been received along with statement of complainant-Pishora Singh. As per the statement and report, the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence. The petitioner as well as the complainant are residents of the same

village and are neighbours. It will certainly promote harmony and cordial relations amongst the parties, if criminal proceedings are dropped.

In view of the above stated position, especially the fact that a compromise has been effected between the parties, FIR No.10 dated 9.2.2014 under Sections 341, 324, 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Raikot, District Ludhiana Rural and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are hereby quashed.
