Pursuant to the order dated 18.03.2017, the learned State counsel today, on instructions from ASI Bhup Singh, Police Station Sirsa City, submits that what learned counsel for petitioners had contented on the last date of hearing, to the effect that all material prosecution witnesses turned hostile, is actually a fact. Thirteen prosecution witnesses still remained to be examined, all of whom are stated to be official witnesses.
