The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.1, dated 07.01.2016, under Sections 336/447/427/506/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 380 of the IPC added later on) and Sections 25(1) & 27(1) of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

This Court, vide order dated 11.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and on his doing so, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 11.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by

the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
