Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.52 dated 15.06.2016, under Sections 302, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Rureke Kalan, District Barnala.

Petitioner was arrested on 17.06.2016 and is in jail since then. This Court did not release the petitioner on bail since the material witnesses/eye witnesses were not examined and cross-examined. Now, learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that all the material witnesses have been examined and all of them have turned hostile to the prosecution.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
