Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.08 dated 08.01.2016, under Sections 307, 34, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

The petitioner was arrested on 25.04.2017 and is in jail since then. Looking to the role of the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner was nominated after two months from the date of offence in question, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
