Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.276 dated 01.12.2007 under Section 302 IPC (the offence under Section 120-B IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station City Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bashir Singh, states that out of 16 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 7 witnesses have already been examined and 2 witnesses were given up. The trial is at advance stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the earlier petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail in CRM-M-17615-2017 was dismissed though as withdrawn on 26.05.2017, coupled with the fact that the trial is at advance stage, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.

However, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
