Petitioner-Manjit Singh has filed this 2nd petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No33 dated 04.03.2017, registered at Police station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur, under Section 306 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, Prashant Mahajan (deceased), who was the eldest brother of complainant-Raghav Mahajan, made an oral dying declaration before the complainant stating that Avtar Singh and Manjit Singh (present petitioner) had come to his house and demanded a sum of Rs.20,000/- The accused demanded the money threatening him that in case, money was not given, they would kill him.

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Due to the harassment caused by the accused persons, Prashant Mahajan had committed suicide.

I have gone through the impugned order dated 11.04.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur. In the said order, it is mentioned that the accused are notorious persons and they are in the habit of extracting money and several criminal cases have been registered against them. The details of four-five FIRs registered against the present petitioner are mentioned in the order dated 11.04.2017.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of nature and gravity of offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
