The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 5 to add the offence under Sections 379-B, 452, 295-A and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and for naming the respondents No.6 to 8 as accused in FIR No.105 dated 07.06.2017 under Sections 323, 341 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana.

Perusal of the FIR in question reveals that the same has been registered at the instance of petitioner No.1-complainant Sonu on 07.06.2017. It has been admitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the matter is still under investigation. Thus, prayer of the petitioners for adding the offence under Sections 379-B, 452, 295-A and 120-B IPC cannot be accepted at this

stage, as it would tantamount to interfere in the case, which is otherwise also being investigated by the police.

Therefore, this Court does not find any merit in the present petition as the same has been filed at pre-matured stage, when the FIR was registered on 07.06.2017, is still under investigation.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
