It is submitted that representation/complaint dated 11.06.2017 (Annexure P1) was submitted by the petitioner through post wherein specific allegations have been raised against repondents No. 4 to 6. The petitinoer even filed an affidavit dated 08.06.2017 on the asking of the police authorities in support of her allegations. However, no action has been taken by the police authorities till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this staage submits that a direction be issued to the police authorities for taking a decision on the complaint/representation submitted by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the petitioner,

facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, it is considered appropriate to dispose of this petition, with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala (respondent No.2) to look into the complaint/representation dated 11.06.2017 (Annexure P1) supported by an affidavit dated 08.06.2017 of the petitioner (Annexure P2) and take appropriate action if any/as may be required.

It is reiterated that none of the observations made here-in-above shall be construed to be a reflection on merits of the case.
