Quashing of FIR No. 188 dated 28.3.2016 under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Sector 7, Faridabad, District Faridabad is being sought on the basis of compromise deed dated 23.1.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Respondent No. 2 got married to Rahul Verma- deceased on 6.5.2011 and a daughter namely Aradhya verma aged about 3 years was also born. Petitioners are the relatives (in-laws) of respondent No. 2. After the death of husband of respondent No. 2, petitioners started harassing her. Due to temperamental differences, both the parties could not live together. The relationship between them became strained and thereafter, F.I.R was registered against the petitioners on account of harassing and humiliating respondent No. 2 on the pretext of bringing insufficient dowry.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised. In compliance of order dated 31.1.2017, report dated 15.2.2017 of District And Sessions Judge, Faridabad has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been recorded. Complainant-respondent No.2 stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does not want

to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioners. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the statements given by petitioners.

Consequently, in view of the status report dated 15.2.2017 and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910*, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 188 dated 28.3.2016 under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Sector 7, Faridabad, District Faridabad, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
