The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.58 dated 04.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406, 498-A, 376, 511, 377 IPC, registered at Police Station, Women, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the both the parties submits that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties at the Mediation Centre of this Court and it has been agreed between the parties that husband-Jatinderpal Singh shall pay Rs.17,00,000/- to the wife-Harpreet Kaur in lieu of dowry articles as well as permanent alimony and maintenance (past, present and future.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of compromise, husband-Jatinderpal Singh has paid Rs.8.5 Lacs by way of draft bearing No.740224. A copy of the demand draft is taken on record. He further submits that the balance payment of Rs.8.5 Lacs shall be paid to

Harpreet Kaur-wife at the time of making final statement in the divorce petitioner under Section 13B of HMA, at the Court at Patiala.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted vide order dated 31.08.2016 is made absolute and the present petition is disposed of.
