ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 15 dated 05.03.2014, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib on the basis of compromise dated 05.08.2017(Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a property dispute between the parties, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

This Court vide order dated 16.08.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court for recording their statements with regard to the genuineness of compromise. The report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malout, dated

06.09.2017, has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded, which indicates that they have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any coercion or pressure.

The FIR is outcome of a property dispute between the parties. Now the matter has been compromised and the parties want to live in peace and harmony.

In view of the law laid down in "*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 15 dated 05.03.2014, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
