It is a case of marriage by petitioners belonging to different religion against wishes of family members of the girl namely Nisha Khan- petitioner No.2. The petitioners are apprehensive that some harm may be caused to them by such family members of petitioner No.2-Nisha Khan who are arrayed as respondents No.4 to 8.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation (**Annexure P-4**) submitted by the petitioners and to provide requisite security to the petitioners, if the circumstances so require. However, this direction will not validate the marriage said to have taken place between the petitioners and will have no effect on any civil or criminal action which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
