Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order dated 8.5.2017 passed by the trial Court (Annexure P-4) whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in FIR No.372/2010 dated 6.9.2010, under Sections 420, 197, 198, 199 and 200 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana and order dated 1.6.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana upholding the order dated 8.5.2017 of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court but the trial Court be directed to decide his bail application expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the trial Court is directed that in case the petitioner surrender before the trial Court within a week from today and moves bail application, the same be decided within two days from the date of filing.
