Through this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for grant of regular bail pending trial to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.171 dated 05.05.2017 registered under Section 20 of the N.D.P.S. Act, at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat.

According to the prosecution, 6.5 kgs ganja was recovered from the petitioner.

According to the custody certificate, filed by learned counsel for the respondent-State, which is taken on record, the actual custody period of the petitioner is 04 months and 22 days.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail during trial, subject to his furnishing personal bond with two

heavy sound local sureties of the like amount, as the petitioner is resident of Bihar, therefore, there are chances that he may not turn up, to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Sonapat.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
