The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.56 dated 05.05.2017, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

Heard.

On 17.08.2017, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel contends that petitioner is mother-in-law and only general allegations have been levelled against her. The husband of the petitioner was arrested and recovery of entire dowry articles have already been effected.

Notice of motion for 19.09.2017.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, she shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That she shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when

required;

2.That she shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;

3.That she shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.08.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
