This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.88 dated 15.06.2016, under Sections 354, 511 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station, Bapoli, District Panipat.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that in this case, cancellation report has since been approved by the Superintendent of Police on 26.01.2017.

In view of the said fact, the interim order dated 31.08.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute and the petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction, subject to the following conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

(i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

(ii) that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make

any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.

(iv) such other condition as may be imposed under sub section (3) of Section 437, as if the bail were granted under that section.

Disposed of accordingly.
