A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

As per the prosecution story, the petitioner is alleged to have informed the assailants about the time of arrival of the deceased and thereafter the assailants are alleged to have killed the deceased and looted gold weighing more than two kilograms. It is submitted by the State Counsel that upon interrogation, recovery of booty has been effected from the petitioner. It is further informed by the State Counsel that the complainant has not yet been examined out of the total number of 15 witnesses, whereas only one of them has been examined so far.

No ground for the grant of bail at this stage thus is made out.
