ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.61 dated 27.05.2017, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148 & 149 of the IPC and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Rahon, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that no injuries are attributed to the petitioners and similarly situated co-accused namely Brahm Singh and Amrik Singh were granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M-22164-2017 on 08.08.2017.

Heard.

In the afore-noted petition bearing CRM-M-22164-2017, the petitioners herein namely Tarsem Singh, Shingara Singh, Kuldeep Singh along with two others namely Brahm Singh and Amrik Singh had jointly prayed for anticipatory bail. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners did not press the petition on

behalf of the petitioners herein namely Tarsem Singh, Shingara Singh and Kuldeep Singh. It is manifest from the perusal of the order dated 08.08.2017 that Brahm Singh was 78 years old and no injury was attributed to him while Amrik Singh was carrying only a *danda* and simple injury on the elbow of injured Karanveer Singh was attributed to him.

The petitioner No.1-Tarsem Singh is stated to be armed with *dattar* while petitioner No.2-Shingara Singh and petitioner No.3-Kuldeep Singh were armed with *gandassi* and therefore, their case would not be at par with Brahm Singh and Amrik Singh.

In any event, after the case for anticipatory bail had not been pressed on behalf of the petitioners in the earlier CRM-M-22164-2017 on 08.08.2017, I am not inclined to take a different view in the matter now. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
