This is an application for placing on record certain documents as Annexures P-7 and P-8.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and documents Annexures P-7 and P-8 are taken on record.

MAIN CASE

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.13 dated 15.01.2017 under Sections 364/302/307/201/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is not named in the FIR, wherein it is mentioned that the deceased was killed by Mahender Singh and Pawan Kumar,

along with wife of the deceased. Mahender Singh is stated to have had illicit relations with the wife of deceased. He further contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused Pawan Kumar. He further contends that petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 08.04.2017 and no recovery has been effected from him.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Devi Lal, states that investigation has been completed and challan has been presented in Court but no prosecution witness has been examined so far.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner has not been named in the FIR wherein three co-accused have been specifically named and the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Ramesh Chand is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
