ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.100, dated 30.09.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Fattudhinga, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that 150 grams of Alprazolam is alleged to be recovered from her. He further states that the petitioner, who is a lady, is suffering from Hepatitis C and liver cirrhosis. A copy of testing and treatment card under the Chief Minister Punjab Hepatitis C Relief Fund Scheme is annexed as Annexure P-2. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 04 months since her date of arrest on 25.07.2017.

In the affidavit filed by the Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, it is stated that the petitioner was found to be positive in HCV Elisa test and she is being treated in Civil Hospital, Kapurthala.

Heard.

In view of the medical condition of the petitioner on account of her suffering from Hepatitis C and liver cirrhosis, it would be appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Baljit Kaur alias Manjit Kaur is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
