Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents to provide adequate police force so as to protect the petitioner and his wife-Usha Rani, who have to otherwise appear in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak, on 01.09.2017, to record the prosecution evidence in case FIR No.0133 dated 05.08.2016 under Sections 148, 149, 302 and 323 IPC, Police Station Lakhan Majra, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner and his wife, namely, Usha Rani are regularly being threatened by the relatives of the family of the accused and the family of the petitioner is living in constant fear. Even otherwise, two of the accused, namely, Summit @ Golu and Vikram have not been arrested by the police so far

wife have the apprehension of attack and they are in dire need of police protection. He has further argued that for the aforesaid grievance, a representation (Annexure P-3) has already been submitted on 02.08.2017, addressed to respondents No.2 and 3 and has shown sufficient reason to extend adequate protection to the petitioner. The accused are from the same village to which the petitioner belongs to.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Munish Sharma, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Taking into consideration the averments made in the petition and considering the fact that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 02.08.2017 (Annexure P-3), present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Superintendent of Police, Rohtak, to look into the contents of representation dated 02.08.2017 (Annexure P-3) and to take adequate measures so as to enable the petitioner and his wife to appear before the trial Court for their evidence on the date fixed or any other subsequent date.
