The present petition has been filed under Section 439 the Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in case FIR No.359 dated 07.11.2016, registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The petitioner is resident of the same locality and it is highly improbable that a person of the same locality would commit the offence of theft in that locality. Even the son of the complainant is fast friend of the petitioner. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 10.11.2016.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application. It is submitted that the petitioner is involved in one more case of theft.

Heard.

As per allegations, the petitioner snatched gold earnings of the complainant, who is an old lady of 70 years. The complainant had to get her ears stitched. Keeping in view the nature of the offence and conduct of the petitioner, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Dismissed.
