Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.173 dated 04.08.2016 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Uklana, District Hisar, on the basis of compromise dated 05.10.2016 (Annexure-P4).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 17.08.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements for compromise with further direction to the Magistrate to furnish report qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hisar on 30.08.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise. Report dated 30.08.2017 from the concerned Magistrate vide his covering letter No.679 dated 31.08.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Hisar vide letter bearing No.20595 dated 31.08.2017 has also been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hisar, the compromise between the parties is genuine, without any feat, threat, pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.173 qua the petitioners, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
