The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.20 dated 24.03.2016 under Sections 307/324/323/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was registered after a delay of 13 days and is an outcome of a sudden fight between the students. He further states that the complainant was discharged after 05 days of the occurrence on 17.03.2016 and has fully recovered and the petitioner is in custody for about six months.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate today in Court, which indicates that petitioner has been in custody for 05 months and 29 days as on 22.08.2017.

The petitioner is a 20 years old student and has been in custody for almost six months. The complainant is stated to have fully recovered.

In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Jugraj Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
