Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.85 dated 10.03.2015 registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak, on the basis of compromise dated 27.07.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide orders dated 18.08.2017 & 28.09.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Meham on 06.10.2017 and got recorded

their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received

vide covering letter bearing No.870 dated 10.10.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Rohtak vide letter No.7096 dated 12.10.2017.

According to the report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Meham, the matter has been compromised between the parties genuinely without any pressure or undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.85, is quashed qua the petitioners.
