Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 not to harass the petitioner on the basis of false and frivolous FIR against his younger brother, namely, Vikas @ Vicky.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner states that an FIR No.874 dated 21.11.2014 under Sections 302/307/120-B/34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 was registered at Police Station Jind City and in the said FIR, brother of the petitioner, namely, Vikas @ Vicky has been named as an accused. The petitioner's family has already disowned him, but still the police is harassing the petitioner despite the fact that the petitioner is not connected in the said offence.

For the aforesaid grievance, petitioner has already moved a complaint dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure P-4) addressed to

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to look into the contents of said complaint dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure P-4).

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observation on the claim projected by the petitioner, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Jind, to look into the contents of complaint dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with law.
