On 11.01.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a qualified BAMS Doctor having degree from Indian Medical Board of Alternative System. Petitioner has also obtained registration certificate from the concerned Board. The petitioner was also granted valid licence and registration certificate by the office of Director, Health and Family Welfare, Punjab under the provisions of NDPS Act.

Notice of motion for 06.02.2017.

Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 23.01.2017 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to

furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In the meanwhile, State may enquire into the validity of documents possessed by the petitioner and submit a report to this effect on the adjourned date.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Jagbinder Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub Division, Tarn Taran on behalf of respondent-State has been filed.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Baldeep Singh submitted that all the documents possessed by the petitioner are found to be genuine as per the verification done by the Police from the Registrar (Evaluation) of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka and Indian Medical Board (Alternative Systems). However, the petitioner has no authority to run any rehabilitation centre at Goindwal Bye-pass.

In view of above, I deem it appropriate to confirm the interim order dated 11.01.2017. Ordered accordingly. However, petitioner shall keep on appearing before the Investigating Officer as and when required.

Petition stands disposed of.
