The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.81 dated 01.06.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 457 and 380 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

Heard.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioners have joined the investigation. The police after completion of investigation, has already presented the challan and he has no objection if the interim bail allowed to the petitioner is made absolute.

In view of submission of learned State counsel but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and

order dated 18.08.2017 is made absolute, subject to the condition that petitioners shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing. In the event of their non-appearance on any date, the trial Court will be competent to cancel their bail and forfeit the bail bonds and surety bonds and take the petitioners into custody.
