In the application, the applicant-petitioner seeks an extension of the interim bail granted to him, on the ground that he has to attend the final ceremonies on 24.09.2017, on account of unexpected death of his sister on 10.09.2017, which fact is sought to be proved by way of a Certificate issued by the Local Councillor, Ward No. 72-S, Bhatti South Delhi Municipal Corporation.

2. Today, the case was fixed for final hearing in connection with the earlier application of the applicant-petitioner, who is presently on interim bail. His bail had been extended only till date. The grounds on which his earlier prayer was allowed are admittedly non-existent now.

3. In the circumstances, the instant application as well as the main case are disposed off with a direction upon the petitioner to surrender before the concerned Jail, from where he was released on interim bail, by the afternoon of 20.09.2017, in which event he may be subsequently released on the evening of 23.09.2017 to attend the death related ceremonies of his sister and to thereafter surrender again by the morning of 25.09.2017.
