Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.104 dated 12.06.2017 under Sections 454, 380, 381 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar.

This Court vide order dated 17.08.2017, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 17.08.2017, petitioners have joined the investigation. He further states that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Avtar Singh, has stated that in terms of above order, petitioners have joined investigation. However, he states that the respondents are not in the knowledge of any compromise entered between the parties.

Be that as it may, petitioners have joined the investigation.

In view of above, present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 17.08.2017 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
